हमारे विद्यालय में हिंदी संकाय, नृत्य संकाय एवं कला संकाय — तीनों विभागों के संयुक्त सहयोग से "हिंदी साहित्य की यात्रा" नामक विशेष कार्यक्रम का आयोजन किया गया। इस कार्यक्रम में कक्षा पाँचवीं से दसवीं तक के विद्यार्थियों ने उत्साहपूर्वक भाग लिया। कार्यक्रम का मुख्य उद्देश्य विद्यार्थियों को हिंदी साहित्य की समृद्ध परंपरा, विविध विधाओं तथा प्रमुख साहित्यकारों से परिचित कराना था।

MOCK DRILL BY TEAM NDRF

A special session was organized on 28.06.2025 at Manava Bharati International School by the National Disaster Response Force (NDRF), Patna, to make students aware and sensitized about disasters and their response measures. The session was led by Inspector Ranvijay Kumar, Battalion Head, NDRF Patna, along with his team.

Students were trained on Pre-Hospital Treatment (PHT), which included essential first-aid techniques for accidents, heavy bleeding, fractures, cardiac arrest, and other emergencies. The team also highlighted various life-saving methods and the importance of quick action during disasters.







It was shared that the NDRF operates 24×7, with fully-equipped vans ready to reach any disaster site within 20 minutes. The session concluded with a mock drill, demonstrating safety steps during natural calamities.

The program proved to be informative and inspiring, preparing students and teachers to handle emergency situations with confidence.
